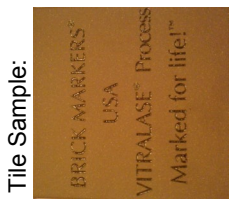

*Walkway of Love*

The loss of a child is traumatizing for a parent...no matter what age the child was...no matter how they die. In fact, "traumatizing" is not near a strong enough word to describe the pain and suffering left behind.

Parents often need a quiet place of solace to nurture their sense of loss, and to remember the life of their child. Perhaps even to honor their memory. The Angel of Hope Memorial Garden will give parents, families and friends a place to:

- remember and honor their child who was taken too soon,
- experience the support of other grieving Maryland parents; a common bond connecting us regardless of age, race, nationality, religion, economic or social status, and
- feel HOPE and HEALING.

The Angel of Hope was introduced to the world through the heartwarming book, *The Christmas Box* by Richard Paul Evans, about a woman who mourns the loss of her child at the base of an angel monument.

The book itself was such a treasure to readers that Richard Paul Evans began receiving letters requesting information about the angel monument. He then commissioned the first Angel monument to be built as a place for parents to grieve the loss of a child.

While the bases and inscriptions of the statues vary, the sculpture is the creation of a father and son from Salt Lake City, Utah, Ortho and Jared Fairbanks, and modeled according to the description in Evans' book. There are now over 100 statues worldwide.

*Memorial Service*

Each year at 7:00 p.m. on December 6<sup>th</sup>, parents, siblings, family members and friends gather together at the Angel of Hope monuments across the world to celebrate the lives and mourn the loss of a child that left too soon.
